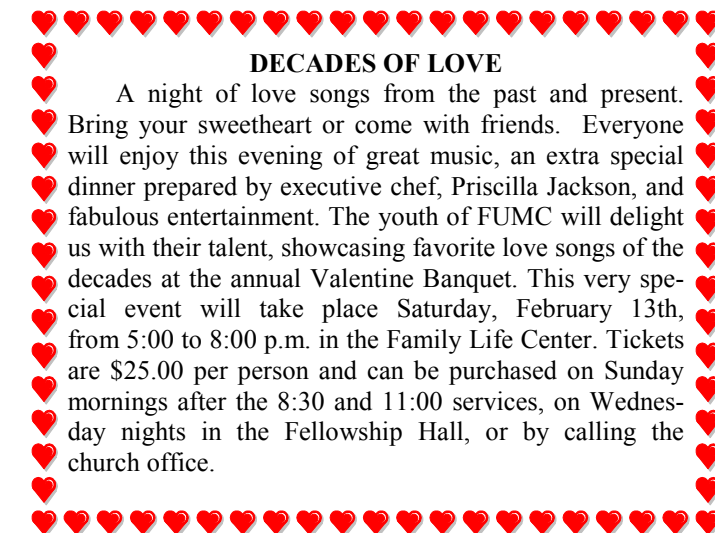
REGISTER NOW FOR 2010 WOMEN'S RETREAT
